SOFTWARE LICENSE AGREEMENT**

IMPORTANT -- BEFORE YOU OPEN THE PACKET CONTAINING THE SOFTWARE, PLEASE
READ THE FOLLOWING AGREEMENT CAREFULLY. BY OPENING THE PACKET
CONTAINING THE SOFTWARE OR BY USING THE SOFTWARE, YOU INDICATE YOUR
ACCEPTANCE OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT.

If you do not agree to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, promptly return the unopened software packet, along with all documentation, where you obtained it for a full refund.

1. Grant of License to Use.

Wideband Computers, Inc. (the "Company"), grants you a non-exclusive license to use its math and Digital Signal Processing Library software contained in the enclosed packet (the "Software"). If you, the customer, are an entity rather than an individual, this license extends only to one designated individual software developer employed by you. If you wish to have other persons use the Software you must purchase an additional Software license for each such person. However, if the software developer for whom you purchased the license leaves your company, this license will terminate as to such individual and will then extend to another single designated individual employed by you.

2. Grant of License to Incorporate in Your Product.

The Company also grants you a non-exclusive, royalty-free license to incorporate one or more individual routines contained in this Software into software you create ("Your Product"), and to distribute those routines along with Your Product. You agree that, in connection with the distribution of Your Product, you will grant your end-users the right to use such routines only under a sublicense which contains the restrictions and disclaimers specified in Sections 3 and 5 below. You may not sublicense or distribute the Software substantially in its entirety, or sublicense or distribute any of its routines except as incorporated into Your Product.

3. License Restrictions.

The Company owns the copyright in the Software. Therefore, except as specifically authorized in Section 2 above, you may

not copy the Software to any other permanent storage medium except that you may (a) make one copy of the Software solely for backup or archival purposes, or (b) transfer the Software to a hard disk and keep the original Software for backup purposes. You may not copy the documentation or manual that comes with the Software. The license rights granted to you are not transferable or assignable, and you may not give anyone else access to the Software by posting it on the internet or otherwise, or sublicense, rent, or lease the Software to anyone else, except as specifically provided in Section 2. You may not modify, translate, decompile, disassemble, or reverse engineer the Software (by running it through a simulator or otherwise).

4.Limited warranty:

The Company warrants to you, as the original end-user, that the diskette on which the Software is recorded will be free from defects in material. and workmanship for a period of ninety (90) days from date you purchased this license. If you return the diskette, along with proof of purchase, to the Company or the dealer from whom you purchased it during the warranty period, and inspection of the disk reveals a covered defect, the Company will arrange to have a new diskette sent to you free of charge. This warranty does not apply to a diskette that has been damaged due to accident, abuse, mistreatment, or improper use. This warranty applies only to the recording medium on which the Software is provided to you, and does not apply to the Software itself. The above shall constitute the Company's only obligations, and your exclusive remedies, with respect to the above warranties.

5.Exclusion of Other Warrenty Of Liability.

EXCEPT FOR THE EXPRESS WARRANTY SET FORTH ABOVE, THE SOFTWARE IS PROVIDED "AS IS", WITH NO OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED. THE COMPANY DISCLAIMS ALL OTHER WARRANTIES INCLUDING THE WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, AND DOES NOT WARRANT THAT THE OPERATION OF THE SOFTWARE WILL BE ERROR-FREE. THE COMPANY SHALL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES ARISING IN CONNECTION WITH THE SOFTWARE OR ITS USE INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO LOSS OF PROFITS, BUSINESS INTERRUPTION, OR LOSS OF

DATA, EVEN IF THE COMPANY HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES. SOME STATES DO NOT ALLOW LIMITATIONS AS TO HOW LONG AN IMPLIED WARRANTY LASTS AND/OR EXCLUSION OR LIMITATIONS OF INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES SO THE ABOVE LIMITATIONS AND/OR EXCLUSIONS MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU. This Agreement shall be governed by the internal laws of the State of California and applicable federal law.
